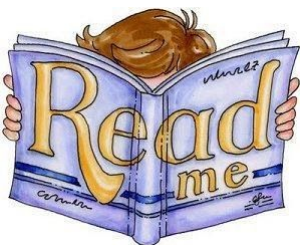
Extreme Reading Competition
